Advancing 30km/h safer school zones – Georgia



- A key partner in EASST's project 'Advancing 30km/h safer school zones' supported by the FIA Foundation working across 7 countries.
- Partnership for Road Safety working at city level to introduce new school zones in Tbilisi, Zugdidi and Rustavi.
- In the last two years, nearly 100 schools zones introduced 30km/h limits.
- In Tbilisi, new school zone standards agreed, and a programme of upgrades underway.
- In Zugdidi, every school has a 30km/h limit.

Star Ratings for Schools in Georgia



- Partnership for Road Safety and the Georgian Automobile Sports Federation. Supported by FIA and FIA Foundation.
- Used the Star Ratings for Schools App to assess 10 schools in Tbilisi and Zugdidi.
- Four schools were selected for upgrades including lower speed limits, new crossings, signage and speed enforcement.
- All four schools now rated as 5 star.



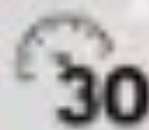
